Our number one priority to keep teachers safe at each school site each and every day. *This means teachers should be protected from parents going onto campus interrupting instructional time.

*This means that administrators should handle any parents coming onto campus to attempt to have impromptu meetings with teachers.

*This also means there should be a district plan in place for lock downs and proper notification of teaching staff when a lockdown had been instituted.

*STA is strongly encouraging the Trustees to give appropriate direction to the Superintendent and Cabinet for creating protocols for certain situations including threats on campus, potential school closures due to fire or other disasters.

*All teachers, staff and students can be best protected when teachers are notified of lockdown and are given situational awareness as efficiently as possible.

*In addition, mainstreaming of students should include informing the general education teacher of the IEP goals so that the mainstream assignment can be more effective for the student and so the teacher has a clear idea of how to align curriculum and instruction towards meeting those goals,
